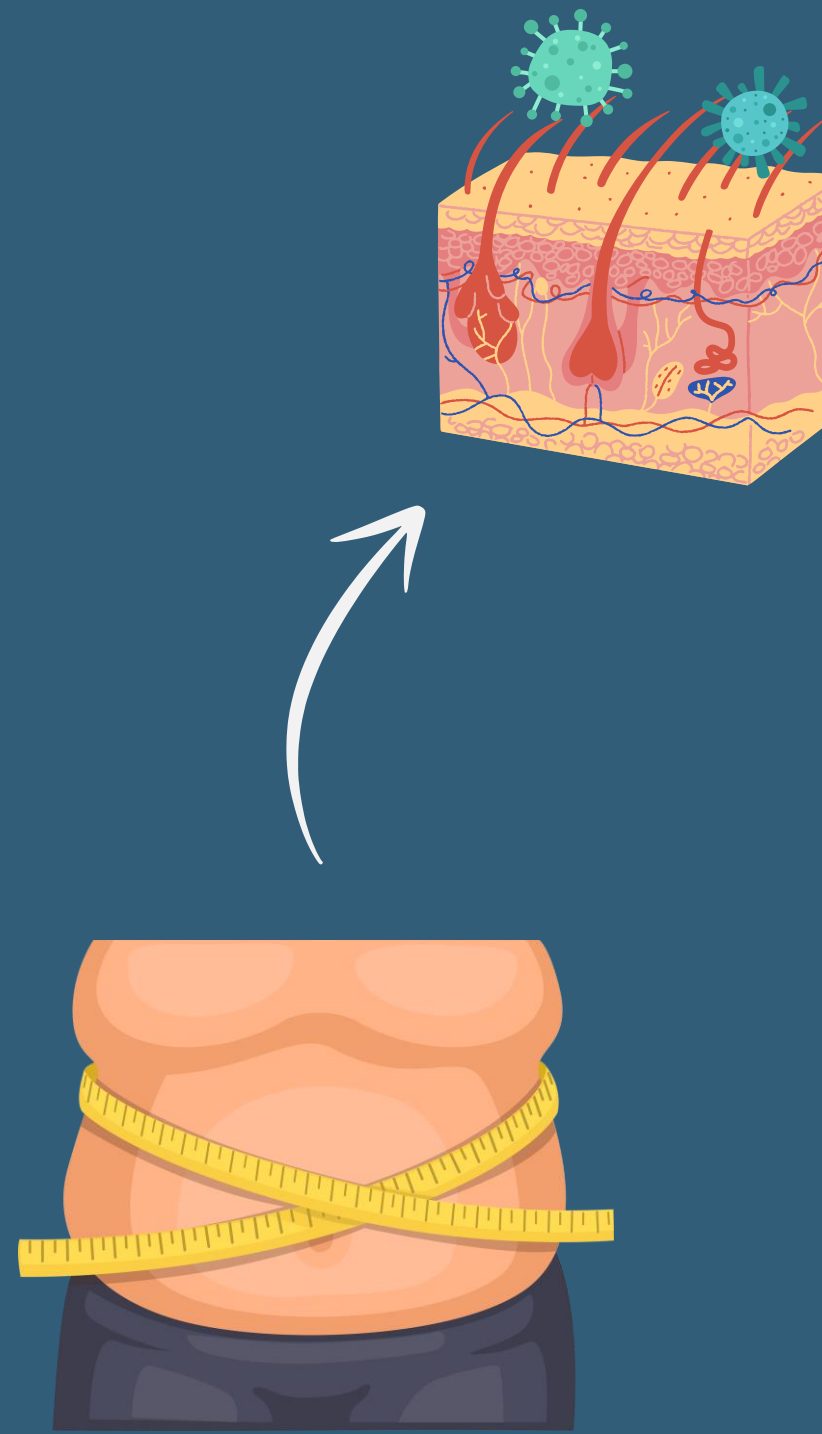
- Infecção bacteriana superficial

 - Wood: vermelho-coral (porfirinas)
 - Exame Direto / HP: cocobacilos gram +
- Fatores de risco:
 - DM, obesidade, umidade, má higiene, idade avançada
